- 1. What makes the Orchard special? What might others not already know about the Orchard?
 - Quiet, peaceful, relaxing, solitude
 - History, seed orchard, heli-pad, mules for Forest Service, fire staging
 - All natural, regeneration beginning
 - Animal habitats (bear, elk, coyotes)
 - Proximity allows for education opportunities, close in
 - Buffer between town and mountains
 - Easy accessibility
 - Low maintenance
 - Illegal activity occurring (motorized use)
 - Previous activities in Mule Pasture were unsuccessful

- <u>Undeveloped, empty area in town to experience nature</u>
- Not busy, no tourists, less people
- Clean

- Hide and seek

- Not great for rec (hot, dry, open)
- It needs rehab (weeds, open field, trees)
- 2. Why do you enjoy living/owning property near the Orchard?
 - Quiet, peaceful, safe, uncrowded area
 - Able to get out on all-natural setting
 - Provides environment/habitat for animals that have been pushed out (moose calving, elk migration, deer, bears)
 - (same as #1)
 - We enjoy that there is no traffic

- We don't want all the areas in town developed
- Being out of town, but in town (wilderness, no development, buffer)
- Open space
- Ponderosa, wild apple and plum trees
- Kids enjoy it (bone collection)
- Beauty
- 3. As a landowner, what ideas related to the future of the Orchard are circling in your head?
 - Why does every space need to be labeled with a use?
 - So many people moving in (influx)
 - <u>Preserves open/natural/undeveloped</u> <u>area</u>
- What next? When does human development stop overtaking open space?
- Want Thompson to remain small, quiet, peaceful, natural

- Why this area? <u>There are other</u> <u>developed areas available</u> (River trail, Ainsworth, Rose Garden)
- Leave it the way it is
- Worry that this is a gateway project that will result in more construction and permanent development
- Who will maintain bathrooms, area, trash in case of development?
- A rural housing development in this area is not wanted
- We do not want to sacrifice this chunk of land, which is an enrichment to all in our community
- Skate park, disc golf park
- Needs to be cleaned up (bears dragging garbage, trees trimmed, fix fence, old sharp metal)
- Worry about making it more public because people think it's public and you can hunt (onX issue)

- Bear proof cans?
- How do we police it?
- Where would you park everyone?
- Anything for youth is really important
- Get out to walk everyday with camera
- <u>Low impact</u>, trying to contain with respect to adjacent folks (sound, smells, lights)
- Don't want kids running stuff supervision
- Kids to take pride (feels like yours)
- Picnic shelter ok
- Community garden
- Place for riding bicycles (Ainsworth = littles), need safer spot for older kids
- No to skateboarding
- XC skiing in winter, bmx in summer same course, no gravel
- Like to see not too busy in future
- Varied accessibility opportunities
- 4. When you think about the future, what would you like to see happen on the Orchard property?
 - Keep it the way it is
 - <u>Fire prevention</u>
 - Keep uniqueness, other places don't have a place like this
 - No housing
 - You can't make more land
 - It has a cool history
 - Extend trail system from Mule Pasture
 - Nothing, except maybe a few trails, maybe a bench, like the East side, access okay
 - Restoration to natural forest (clean-up diseased trees, thin orchard, more native species, less weeds)
 - Or put in something for the kids

- Nothing too permanent
- Archery range would be good international sport opportunity for kids
- Anything that happens should be ADA accessible
- Open to anyone at no cost
- Weed pulling days
- Adopt-a-something for maintenance
- Not maintaining Mule Pasture is concern to future Orchard
- Day use only
- Helicopter area has potential
- No noise pollution, don't want to create distraction
- Porta Potties (kids there all the time?)
- Pack it in, pack it out
